

Sunday School Report - 2011

January to June

From January to June we continued to use the “stories on the way” curriculum, which was provided by Rev. Michelle. The children learnt about Jesus’ baptism, playing water charades, which they loved! We looked at how we are called to be His disciples, to trust and follow; the children took turns leading the others (eyes closed) around an obstacle course. The children collected funds for PWRDF and Berty Ho-Wo Cheong came to speak to them about it. Easter Sunday, the children were given tambourines and shakers, to join the praise team. During Pentecost the children learnt how to say Peace in different languages and shared this with the congregation.

September to December

Currently in this new session there are 6 students registered. There is more attendance during special services but we still maintain the 1 classroom setting. To this end, we try to make sure that all activities and crafts are geared for all ages.
