Executive Summary

The Church of St. Michael and All Angels is a self-supporting pastoral-sized parish of 78 families and 44 individuals in Pierrefonds, Quebec on the northwestern side of Montreal Island, in the Diocese of Montreal. This is a residential community that consists of a slight majority of English-speaking people many with various ethnic backgrounds. The church population reflects this mix.

The church has a variety of age groups including a very active youth group. Sunday worship occurs at two services: a traditional service with organ music at 8:00 AM and a contemporary service with praise and traditional music accompanied by organ, piano, guitar and drums at 10:00 AM. Complementary to the 10:00 AM service are Sunday school, Youth Church and Healing Prayer. We are working to help people discover the fullness of their life in Jesus Christ in which they experience the release of the Holy Spirit and his gifts for ministry.

The parish is seeking a priest who will bring it new vitality and growth, who will be dedicated to leading it into a deeper knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ, who will be an enthusiastic and energetic priest who will love, empower, inspire, nurture and equip the parishioners to grow in their faith. The incumbent will be prayerful and pastoral, will enjoy teaching from the Scriptures and will encourage leadership and participation in a variety of ministries. The priest will be able to work with all age groups including the youth. Good communication skills will be an asset. St. Michael and All Angels is accustomed to a shared leadership one that both listens and responds to the parish through its active Parish Council and variety of ministries.
