All of us have to purchase food for our families; gas for the car, clothing, and bus passes to get to work, as well as health and beauty products, and prescriptions. Some of us also make renovations to our homes, have car repairs to make, or sport equipment to purchase. All of the purchases can be made and more using Fundscrip and its sponsors. The basic cards can be purchased every week after church, and if we don't have what you're looking for, orders can be made for the following week.
