

Sunday school Report 2010

September to December

In this new session we decided to follow a curriculum, called Stories on the Way suggested to me by Rev. Michelle. The curriculum teaches the same story with different perspectives and activities for a number of weeks. The lessons are adaptable to the small number of children that attend each week (between 4 and 7).

Our first lesson looked at the creation, in which the children made their own earth balls (hung up in corner hall), to remind them that we have to take care of God's creation, "don't drop the ball". Then we looked at Moses and the burning bush, followed by the Ten Commandments. We then proceeded to work on our Christmas pageant. For the pageant I decided to do something a little different. The children told the Christmas story using puppets, which was enjoyed by all on Christmas Eve.

January to June

We still have the same number of children attending (between 4 and 7). Our first lesson was taken from Stories on the Way. It focused on the waters of baptism; we played "Water Charades", which the children loved. In the weeks to come we will be looking at the Calling of the disciples, Walking on Water, Jesus' Temptation, The Last Supper, The Passion and Resurrection, Parable of the Sheep, Story of Pentecost and Psalm 139.

I am excited to continue to work with the children and team of teachers (6) in exploring our faith in Christ together.
